PROVISIONAL ADMISSION

1. Earned baccalaureate degree from a regionally accredited institution.
2. An earned 2.5 grade point average or higher on the last 60 hours of undergraduate work.
3. Evidence of T-4 certification.
4. Two letters of recommendations MUST address professional demeanor with peers, students and parents. The letters MUST also address personal disposition regarding the candidate's initiative and responsibility for his/her own learning.
5. Letter of intent.
6. Signed COE permission for criminal background check (waived with proof of employment in a public school system).
7. Proof of instructional liability insurance (waived with proof of employment in a public school system).
8. Verification of employment form if candidate is a full time teacher.
9. A student must take two courses taught by Early Childhood full-time faculty members and obtain 3.0 or better. The Department Head must approve the courses.

REGULAR ADMISSION

1. Earned baccalaureate degree from a regionally accredited institution.
2. An earned 3.0 grade point average in the last 60 hours of undergraduate work.
